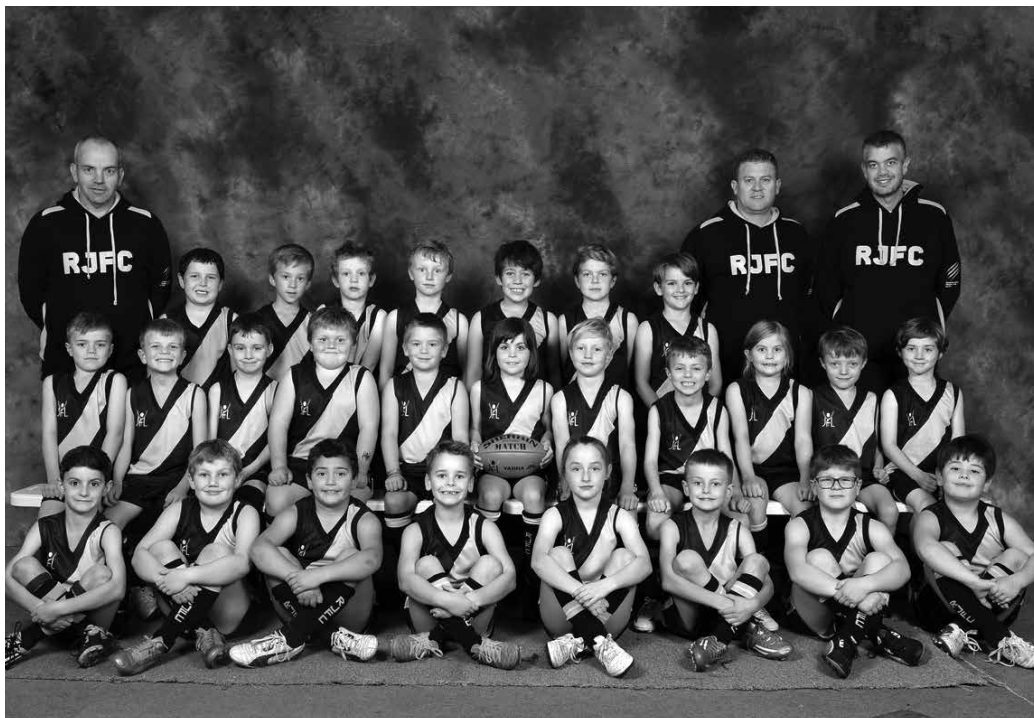

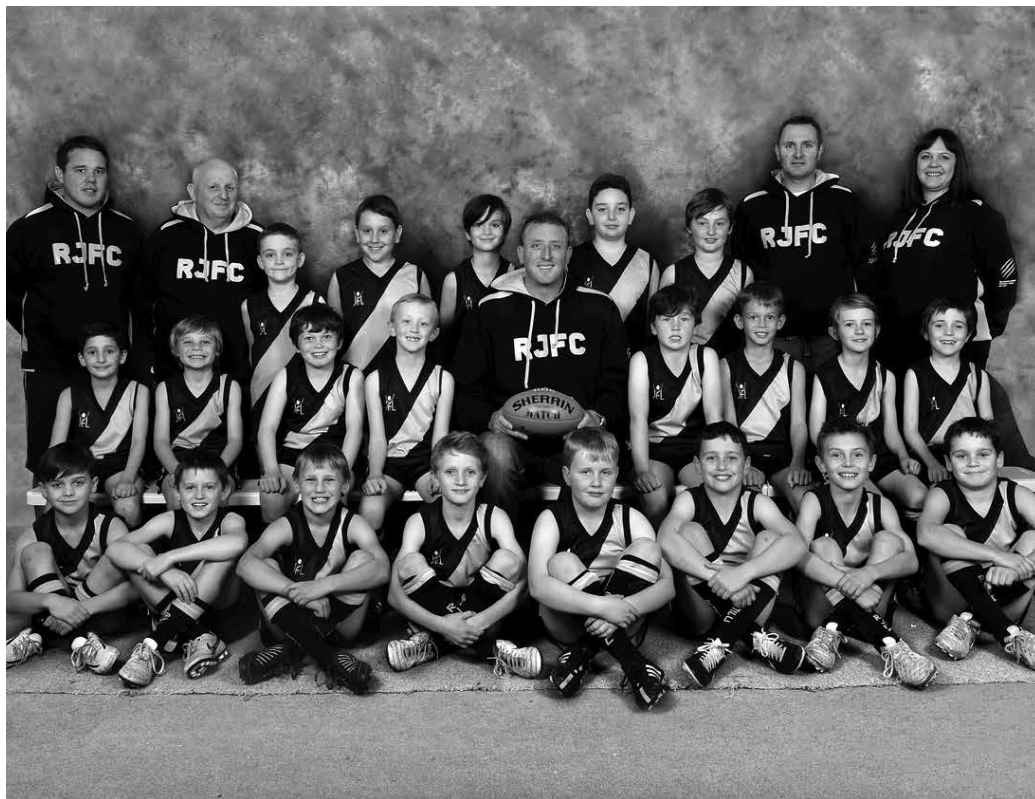
What a bunch of great kids who gave it their all and had a crack all year, especially during the coldest winter we've had for a long time.

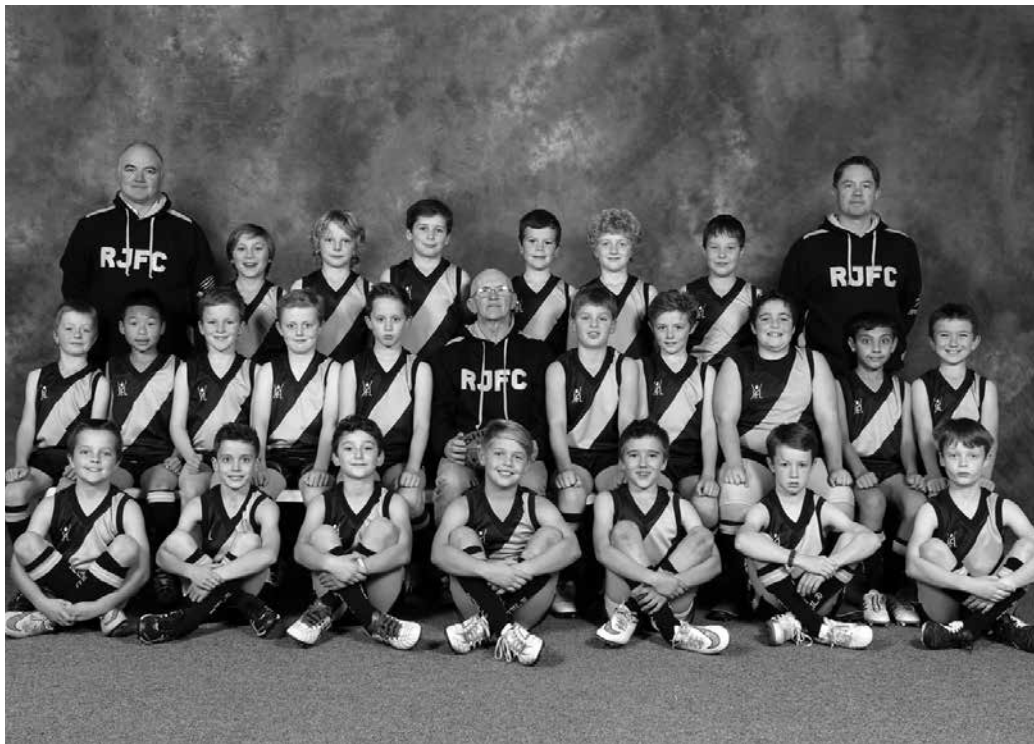

I am confident that this group will not only account for themselves well next season but will be a good team for RJFC for years to come.

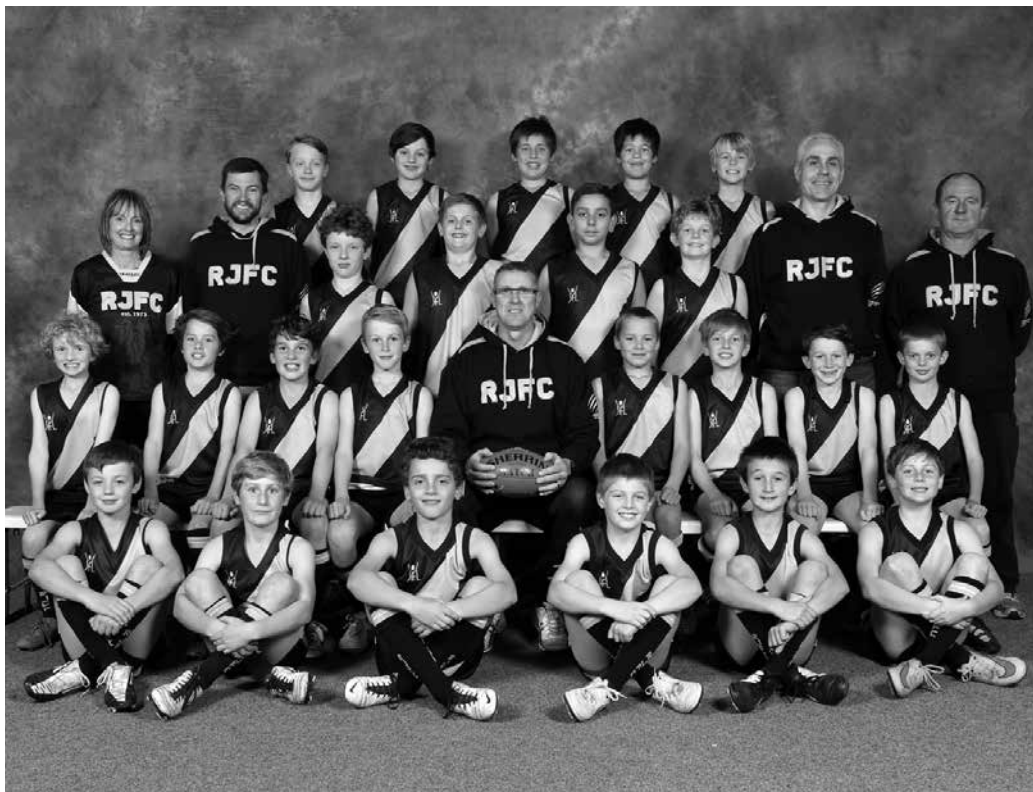

After the pain of losing the grand final in 2014, the boys started the season strong with 4 wins including a great come from behind win against Fitzroy and a first class performance against Parkside.

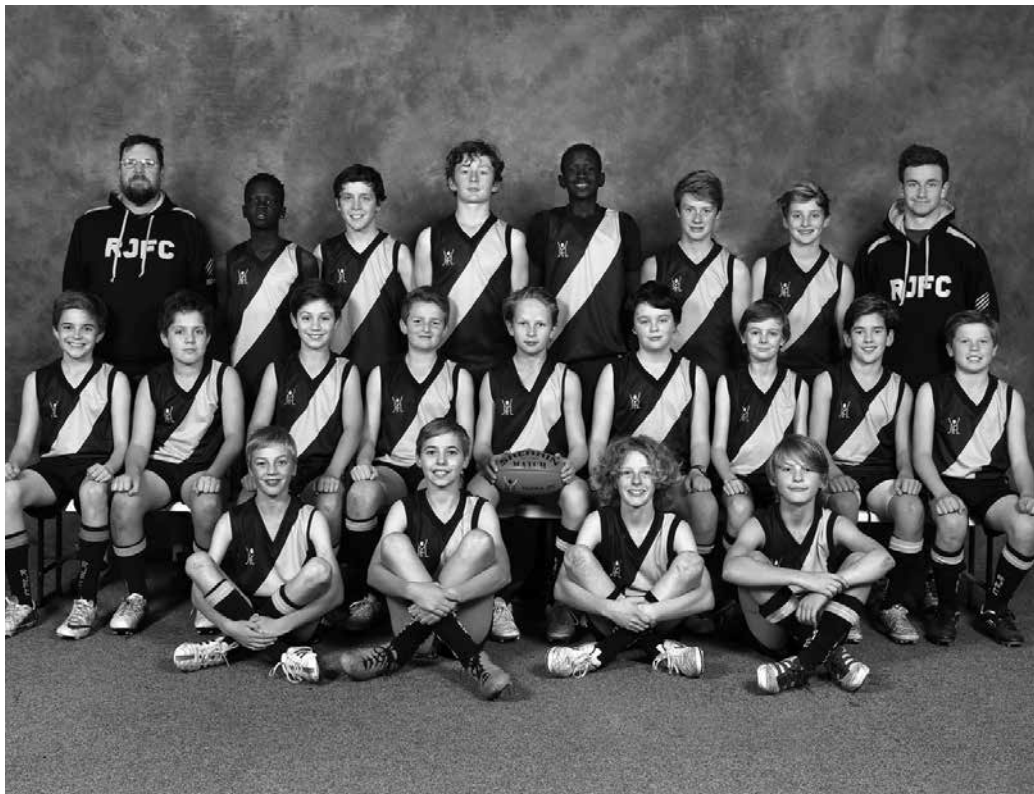
The strong start meant the team moved up a grade, which would be the second grade move since the 2014 grand final.

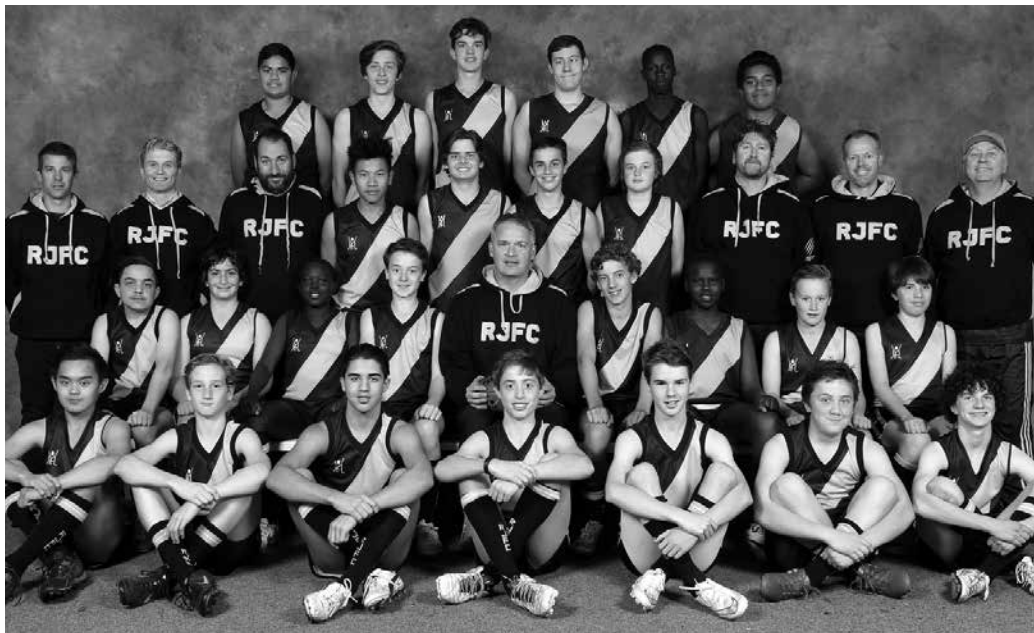
